*Income-Eligible Guidelines*

Your family's income (before deductions) must be less than:

The **DACP** will pay up to \$250 per child (ages 18 and under) for a summer activity you choose. Any cost above that must be paid by parents. Just complete the attached application and return it by June 30, 2018 with a \$5 fee for each child.

There is an attached list of summer camps and programs, or you can choose a different summer activity. You must apply to the camp yourself. When applying to camps write "*I have applied to the Doli Atamian Campership Program*" where it asks for payment and we will pay them directly.

We ask that your child submit a thank you letter or drawing after their camp experience. This helps us with fundraising. If you have any questions, please call or email us using the information above.
