Dear Applicant:

The **Doli Atamian Campership Program (DACP)** can help pay for your child's summer camp, summer school, or other summer activity. In order to apply for a scholarship, you must be living in either Acton or Boxborough and must meet at least one of the following criteria: 1) you are a client of Acton or Boxborough Housing Authority, 2) your child/children receive free or reduced lunch at school, or 3) your family meets the Income-Eligible Guidelines below:

Income-Eligible Guidelines

DACP may consider unusual circumstances when evaluating income eligibility. If you have a current Mass Child Care Voucher you are not eligible.

Your family's income (before deductions) must be less than:

2 person household \$58,450	6 person household \$84,750
3 person household \$65,750	7 person household \$90,600
4 person household \$73,050	8 person household \$96,450
5 person household \$78,900	

DACP will pay up to \$300 per child (ages 3 through high school students) for a summer activity you choose. DACP does not fund daycare. Any cost above \$300 must be paid by parents. Just complete the attached application and return it by June 30, 2021 with a \$5 fee for each child.

There is an attached list of summer camps and programs, or you can choose a different summer activity. You must apply to the camp yourself. When applying to camps write *"I have applied to the Doli Atamian Campership Program"* where it asks for payment and we will pay them directly.

We ask that your child submit a thank you letter or drawing after their camp experience. This helps us with fundraising. No names are shared with the public. If you have any questions, please call or email us using the information above.
